Parenting Through Change™ is an evidence-based, hands-on, 10-week group for caregivers of children with challenging behaviors. Participation in PTC will enhance existing skills, as well as offer hope, support and new parenting strategies.

PTC is tailored for mental health and behavioral problems in youth ages pre-K through adolescence, and supports families in facing complex challenges:

- Defiance and Aggression
- Delinquency
- Hyperactivity
- School Difficulties
- Problems with Peers
- Depression and Anxiety



PTC is for: Parents of elementary and middle school youth who would benefit from support in managing their children's behaviors and increasing school success.

Group Meeting Details: 90 minute, weekly virtual (Zoom) meetings for 10 weeks. Zoom link will be sent once enrolled in group. Groups are recorded for facilitator training purposes.
